Introduction

The Wallasey & West Wirral Adult Mental Health Team is a Community Mental Health Team based at the Stein Centre, St. Catherine's Hospital, Birkenhead, Wirral. Out-patient clinics are based at the Highfield Centre, Victoria Central Hospital; Springview, Clatterbridge Hospital and West Kirby Health Centre.

Wallasey & West Wirral Adult Mental Health Service provide assessment, treatment, care and support for people with severe and enduring mental health disorders.

The team is multidisciplinary which means that we have staff from a range of different health and social care professions; this enables us to provide all aspects of care.

We offer all types of student placements and often (but only with your consent) we bring students along on visits.

Who are we?

Our team consists of a range of staff including:

- team managers
- consultant psychiatrists
- a range of other grades of psychiatrists
- · approved mental health practitioner
- clinical psychologist
- occupational therapist
- clinical co-ordinator
- community mental health nurse (CMHN)
- support workers
- administration staff

family support worker

What do we do?

- co-ordinate your care
- help you to get the care/services that you require
- explain your care plan
- offer a range of treatments such as medication, talking therapies, social interventions and education, and can provide you with further information on these treatments.
- visit you in a variety of places including at home
- support you to be as independent as is possible
- monitor your medication
- help you to move forward e.g. rehabilitative interventions, getting back to work or education
- help you to be less socially isolated
- monitor your needs in the outpatient department
- review your care plan regularly any contact with you will give us a chance to review your care plan, not just at care programme approach (CPA) reviews

What is the care programme approach (CPA)?

The care programme approach helps us to care for you effectively and involve you in your own care.

Everyone on the CPA level of care has a copy of their own care plan and has their own care co-ordinator who regularly reviews the care plan. There are two levels of care, Standard and CPA.

Standard

This level only requires intervention from one team member and this is usually the Psychiatrist or Lead Professional. You may request a copy of correspondence identifying your care plan. Some patients are monitored by Nurse Practitioners in Practitioner Lead Clinics.

CPA

If you are on this level, it is because you might need more intervention and therefore more team members are involved. You can move between standard and CPA depending on your needs at a particular time.
