#### Where is the service provided?

The service is provided at the following locations and is available Monday to Friday 9-5pm:

People who access our services are welcome to talk to the Team Manager if they are experiencing any problems with their care During this appointment the nurse specialist will determine, along with yourself and your carer (if present), the most appropriate intervention to help you, which may include medication and sign posting to other services. In addition support will be offered for your carer and advice on other aspects of your well-being.

## What happens next?

The team will advise you about the nature of your memory problems and any treatment you require or make arrangements for further tests (if the diagnosis is unclear).

#### **Medication**

If you are prescribed medication a letter will be issued to your general practitioner detailing what is to be prescribed. You will also be given an information leaflet about the medication. Please do not hesitate to contact the team if you have any questions about the medication you are taking.

#### Attendance at appointments

If you are unable to keep your appointment please contact the service on the number overleaf at the earliest opportunity and arrangements will be made to send you another appointment.

#### Introduction

The Wirral Memory Service is based at The Stein Centre, St Catherine's Hospital. The Service provides assessment for people who have suspected or diagnosed cognitive impairment, including problems with forgetfulness, confusion, language and behaviour. Where clinically appropriate antidementia drugs will be prescribed (acetylcholinesterase inhibitors or memantine).

Referrals will be received from general practitioners and other health and social care professionals.

#### Your team

The team is made up of a consultant psychiatrist, clinical nurse specialist, administrative and support staff. The team also work in conjunction with Age UK, providing assessments and carer support.

### Your diagnosis

Your initial appointment will be with the nurse specialist who will take a detailed history of your health and it would be helpful if you could bring a relative, carer, friend or advocate to this meeting. This appointment will usually last just over an hour.
