Staff will talk to you about this information and explain these things to you.



Some of this information may also be in your care plans.

You will notice that some of the doors are locked on Thorn Heys.

The entrance door




The entrance door to Thorn Heys is always locked for safety and security. This stops people walking onto the unit. People need permission from staff before they come into the unit.

Your care plan will tell you if you can leave the unit with staff or on your own.

Clothing

Thorn Heys You can choose the clothes you want to wear at Thorn Heys.



Please wear a dressing gown over your nightclothes when you are in areas like the lounge and dining room.







You should wear socks and slippers when you are walking around the unit. This is to stop you slipping and hurting yourself.

Shouting and swearing

Please respect other people and do not shout or swear at Thorn Heys.
Shouting and swearing can upset other service users.

Talk to staff if you feel angry or worried about anything and they will help you.

Your bedroom

You will have your own bedroom. Your bedroom is your private space. You have a wardrobe and drawers for your clothes.

You will be offered a key for your room.





Electrical Equipment

You can bring your own electrical equipment to Thorn Heys but you are

responsible for looking after it.





If you bring any electrical equipment to Thorn Heys it must be checked by staff from the estates department.

They will check it is safe to use. Staff will arrange this for you.



Please do not lend your electrical equipment to other service users.

Do not play your music or games too loudly as the noise disturbs the other service users on the unit.



The kitchen door

The kitchen door is closed for health and safety reasons.

There is equipment in the kitchen which can be dangerous if it is not used properly.



Drinks will be offered often during the day. You can have a drink when you want one. Staff will make you a snack if you want one.

The office door

The office has information about you and other service users which must be kept safe and confidential.



Your information is kept in a file in the office.

You can look at your information at any time. Staff will help you to read your information.

No smoking

All health service buildings are no smoking.
This means you cannot smoke inside
Thorn Heys.

We want to help you to be healthy and staff can support you to give up smoking.



Lighters and matches




Lighters and matches must be given to staff when you come to Thorn Heys.
