Staff at CAMHS want to find the best way to help you.

To do this I will need to find out some things about you.

I will talk to you and I will talk to other people who know you well.



I will share the things you tell me at team meetings.

I might need to share the things you tell me with other services.

This is to make sure you are getting help from the people who can support you best.



You can tell me if there are people you do not want me to talk to.
We can talk about this together.

Your information is put on a file on the computer.

Your information is safe and secure.

If you want to see your information ask someone to help you.



Your Cheshire Care Record



We need to ask for your consent to view your **Cheshire Care Record.**

This is a file on the computer which has information about you from other health and social care services like your GP, hospital and other professionals.

Having access to this information can really help us to get a better understanding of the care and treatment that you need.

It means that you don't have to keep repeating your health or social care story.



We need your consent to view this information.

If you do not want your information to be in the Cheshire Care Record you need to tell your GP.

If you give your consent

Your information will be held securely.



Staff from other health and social care services will be able to view your Cheshire Care Record.

Your information will only be shared with the staff that are directly involved in your care.
