### Who we are and what we do?

The service aims to improve overall health and justice outcomes for people with a range of vulnerabilities or complex needs and to support people in the reduction of reoffending.

To ensure that people with mental health, learning disability, substance misuse problems and any other vulnerabilities are identified and assessed as early as possible, to ensure the right support can be put in place from the start as they pass through the criminal justice system.

The team consists of Clinical Leads, Liaison and Diversion Practitioners (mental health nurses, learning disability nurses, occupational therapists & social workers), Health Liaison and Diversion Facilitators (HLDF), support navigators & peer support workers. Providing initial screening, case identification, rapid assessments, liaison, signposting & supporting people through the criminal justice process, making onward referrals into appropriate health and social care services, or enable people to be diverted away from the criminal justice system into the most appropriate setting if required.

### Who is our service for?

Our service is an ageless service accessible to all vulnerable people, who are in contact with the criminal justice system.
