## Who are the Early Years Workers?

The Early Years Workers are based in each main site Children's Centre and they work across the district within the community. They deliver groups through the children's centers as well as 1:1 support in the home.

Through your time with an Early Years Worker they will chat to you about what your child likes to do, watch your child play and then plan activities and model them in a way that is easy for you to copy at home.

Early Years Worker support can help children to make progress in many areas of their development. All sessions led by an Early Years Worker promote play, interaction, stimulation, language development, physical development and emotional well-being.

## What to expect:

By signing and returning the section of this form you are agreeing for an Early Years Worker to make contact to give you and your child the opportunity to :-

- take part in a stage appropriate activities that are planned around your child's interest
- talk about play, and share ideas
- get new and simple play ideas to practice at home
- learn new songs, rhymes and stories
- Find out what else is available for you and your family to attend through the local Children's Centre
