Same-sex accommodation

Caring for your privacy and dignity by delivering same-sex accommodation in hospital

Care • Well-being • Partnership

What does same-sex accommodation mean?

The Delivering Same-Sex Accommodation (DSSA) programme, launched in January 2009 by the Strategic Health Authority (SHA), is an initiative to make sure patients and service users in NHS funded care do not usually have to share sleeping accommodation or toilet facilities with members of the opposite sex.

The NHS is committed to providing patients with same-sex accommodation to safeguard their privacy and dignity when people are often at their most vulnerable in hospital.

This means providing a same-sex sleeping area, bathroom and toilet facilities.

What is the difference between a ward and accommodation?

A ward is an area or unit of a hospital (or a suite of rooms) shared by patients who need a similar kind of care.

This includes communal lounges, kitchens, meeting rooms etc.

Accommodation is the facilities that relate to service users needs when they are an inpatient.

Accommodation is a service user's sleeping area, bathroom, washing and toilet facilities.

Improving the patient experience whilst in hospital

CWP aims to provide patients with a comfortable environment that respects an individual's needs and privacy whilst they are in hospital.

By providing same sex accommodation, the Trust aims to remove the potential distress and concern that patients may have in mixed sex accommodation.

Same sex accommodation at CWP

CWP aims to provide same sex accommodation where possible and as soon as possible for all patients admitted to inpatient hospitals.

Sometimes this cannot be provided immediately in special or unusual circumstances where clinical need becomes the priority.

However, all patients' interests will be considered and the situation will be improved and changed as soon as it is feasible.

Young people's needs and group preferences may be different to an adult (ie. age). This will be taken into consideration and patients are given the choice where possible.

Patients will not be turned away if single sex accommodation is not immediately available.
