## What is Spiritual Care?

Spiritual Care encourages people to look at important issues such as anxiety, guilt, forgiveness, anger, dignity, dependency, self-worth, loneliness, identity, belief and trust.

It also provides people with the opportunity to express their feelings, fears, opinions and questions about inner pain, relationship worries, the meaning of illness.

- **Why is this happening?**
- **Why doesn't God help me?**
- **Is there anything after this life?**
- **I am so angry**
- **I will never be able to forgive myself**

These questions and comments, linked with important life issues, are approached carefully and sensitively with each service user as part of their spiritual health care.

It is hoped that service users will be helped to face their problems and difficulties with honesty and integrity, as all feelings need to be recognised and, if possible, brought out into the open.

## What do Chaplains do?

Our Chaplains are available to talk to, or meet with, you, your family, friends, carers and members of staff.

The Hospital's Chaplaincy provision includes:

- A professional and confidential service
- A caring, attentive and accepting presence
- Help and support to encourage inner strength and trust
- A point of contact with the appropriate faith community.

As part of the wider care, Chaplains:

- Acknowledge the right and integrity of every individual
- Treat with respect all religious, ethical and philosophical traditions
